Services We Offer

Stroke Rehabilitation - For stroke, traumatic brain injury/concussion, brain surgeries, neuro-degenerative diseases, spinal cord injury, spasticity management, peripheral neuropathies, nerve injuries and neuro-muscular diseases, and balance and coordination.

Cancer Rehabilitation - Focuses on helping with symptoms like lymphoedema, balance issues, difficulty in swallowing, issues with bowel and bladder, mood disorders, and panic attacks.

Ortho & Trauma Rehabilitation - Specialises in treatments for back, neck, shoulder, arm, hip, knee & ankle pain, sport injury, arthritis/fibromyalgia, joint sprains/strains, and muscular strain.

Cardio Pulmonary Rehabilitation - For Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD), asthma, Congestive Cardiac Failure (CCF), respiratory infections, i.e. pneumonia, peripheral vascular disease, myocardial infarction, and heart or lung injury/surgery.





Geriatric Rehabilitation - To restore function or enhance residual functional capacity and improve the quality of life in older people, particularly those with disabling impairments or frailty.

Paediatric Rehabilitation - Tailored for children with developmental, neurological, or orthopaedic conditions, like cerebral palsy, down syndrome and autism, other neurological disorders like genetic syndromes, and all paediatric orthopaedic conditions.

Sports Medicine & Sports Injury rehabilitation - For sports-related injuries like muscle tears, ligament or tendon injury, periarticular fracture, repetitive/overuse injuries, tennis/golfers elbow, runners' knee, achilles tendonitis, rotator cuff injury, cruciate ligament, meniscal repair, recurrent dislocation, Anterior Cruciate Ligament (ACL) reconstruction surgery, revision of failed ACL reconstruction surgery, Superior Labrum, Anterior to Posterior (SLAP) repair and patella femoral pain syndrome.

Other Priority Focus Areas - Speech and language management, occupational therapy, and psychotherapy.

To help stabilise their blood pressure and facilitate weight bearing, for patients confined to bed.



Enhances mobility, strength, and trunk control for those struggling with walking.



Strengthens both upper and lower limbs for improved mobility.



Enhances cardiopulmonary function by working on upper and lower limbs while seated.



Improves static and dynamic standing balance for patients unable to stand for long periods.



Facilitates walking after spinal cord injury or muscle tightness.



Alleviates pain, muscle spasms, and inflammation while reducing stiffness and oedema.



Enables activities of daily living and reduces fall risk.



Engages patients with games to improve attention, memory, and executive function.



Assists in alleviating pain, muscle spasms, inflammation, stiffness, oedema, and adhesions.



If a patient requires emergency assistance during their rehabilitation, they can receive immediate care in the resuscitation room. A patient facing cognitive challenges such as poor attention, concentration, memory impairment, restlessness, or insomnia due to brain injury will require psychotherapy. The MIOT Rehab Centre, Mauritius, features accessible restrooms equipped with grab bars, enhancing patient convenience. MIOT's Next-Gen Telemedicine services connect the doctor with the patients in real-time. Basic vital signs monitoring, such as pulse rate, blood pressure, respiratory rate, temperature, and BMI, can also be conducted in real-time during the teleconsultation, allowing for prompt feedback from the super-specialist from MIOT International.



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
